\$1000 SIGN ON BONUS

\$300 REFERRAL BONUS

SIGN ON BONUS

- New nurses must work 1000 hours to receive the \$1000 bonus.
- New nurses will not be eligible to receive a sign-on bonus if they have already received a sign-on bonus from PNS in the past 24 months.
- If you are referred by a current nurse, you must put their name in the referral section of your employment application for them to receive their referral bonus.
- Nurses will only be eligible for a bonus if they have not been an active PNS employee within the past 12 months

REFERRAL BONUS

- The new nurse must put the referring nurse's name on their employment application for that referring nurse to also receive their \$300 bonus.
- Only active employees will be eligible to receive referral bonuses.
- Both the referring nurse, and new nurse will receive their respective bonuses once the new hire's 1000 hours are completed
- If a new nurse lists more than one current employee as their referral, the referral portion of the bonus will be split evenly amongst them. (For example, the new nurse would receive their \$1000 sign-on bonus after completing his/her 1000 hours. If they listed two current employees as referrals, they would each receive \$150 also, after the new nurse completed their 1000 hours.)
